The inaugural conference is only about a month away. Our colleagues in Beijing are hard at work finalizing the arrangements and determined to provide us with a great experience. The finalized conference program will consist of 136 papers, selected after a rigorous blind review process, from 288 submissions. In addition to 90 papers in the English program, there will be a China Forum with 46 papers to be delivered in the Chinese language. On top of the reviewed papers, there will be three distinguished speaker panels in the English program and one keynote panel in the Chinese program. Furthermore, there will be several Executive speakers, Professional Development Workshops, Company Visits, along with an Editors' panel representing four top tier journals in our field: Academy of Management Journal, Journal of Applied Psychology, Journal of International Business Studies, and Organization Science. You are cordially invited to the reception where you can meet the other conference participants, enjoy some refreshments, and listen to Chinese music performed by students of Peking University.

The Conference will provide a buffet lunch each day as part of the lunch programs (consisting of a Deans' Panel, Awards Presentation ceremony, and Editors' Panel). Please refer to the Conference program for details on the lunch programs. There will be a served dinner on June 17th and 19th evening, after which we will enjoy corporate speakers and a cultural program performed by students of Renmin University and Tsinghua University, respectively.

This Inaugural Conference will be a major milestone in the short history of IACMR and we hope that it will become a memorable occasion for all of the participants.
