

“中国公共领域的认知与决策”国际学术研讨会

The emergence of national strength and achievement of China has aroused attention from all walks of life, accompanied by a growing concern on the problems entailed by the rise that need to be resolved scientifically. A perceptive, minded actor is the heart of public administration, which indicates that a comprehension of

social development and obstacles in China is supposed to start from an observation of people's thoughts and actions. When the world's spotlight is on China, we yearn to focus on the cognition and decision of public policy in a Chinese mode: How does government make a decision? Why they choose this but not that? How about the practice of this decision? And what troubles are embedded within a choice? Answering the above questions will enable us to present an academic support for the formulation, amelioration and institutional construction of public policy in China, and refine a fundamental theoretical system regarding Public Administration, Cognitive Science and Social Psychology. This academic conference, based on an "issue-oriented" discussion, aims at converging prominent scholars in the domain of Public Administration, Political Science, Psychology, Sociology and Cognitive Science, to have an interdisciplinary academic dialogue over the cognition and decision of public policy in China, and promote a interdisciplinary cooperation among experts.
