

Jinsha Ruins Museum (金沙遗址)

1. Brief Introduction

Situated in Jinsha Village, Supo County, the western outskirts of Chengdu, Jinsha Ruins is one of the most important archaeological discoveries since Sanxingdui Ruins was unearthed in Sichuan Province. The excavation



of Jinsha

Ruins is of great importance to the research into the history and culture of ancient Shu kingdom. There are two halls. One is excavation hall. You can see with your own eyes how the archaeologists excavate. Another one is exhibition

hall which display different kinds of precious relics. More than 1000 invaluable cultural relics were unearthed in the site, including over 30 gold articles, over 400 jade wares, over 400 copper wares, 170 stone articles, over 40 ivory articles, and ivories with the total weight of nearly one ton. Further excavation will possibly result in more important discoveries.

Chengdu Research Base of Giant Panda Breeding (熊猫基地)

1. Brief Introduction



Established in 1987, Chengdu Research Base of Giant Panda Breeding is 10 kilometers from the north suburb of Chengdu City. It covers an area of 600 acres. The Panda base is in imitation of wild life habitat for adult giant pandas. The environment there is exquisitely

designed; the air is refreshing with the bamboo growing luxuriantly and flocks of wild birds flying around. There are 39 giant pandas and other animals such as red pandas and black-necked cranes. The Giant Panda Museum, Butterfly Exhibit Hall and



Vertebrae Animal Exhibit are located in the Base. Chengdu Research Base of Giant Panda Breeding is the most famous conservation and protection center for giant pandas. What's more, it is the most ideal tourism place for visitors all around world to get to

know the appearance of giant pandas and to get around the wild nature.

Emei Mountain (峨眉山)

1. Brief Introduction

Emei Mountain lies seven kilometers southwest of Emeishan City and is one of the four famous mountains in China. It was included in the UNESCO world heritage list in 1996. The mountain stretches more than 200 kilometers from south to north. Its main peak, Wanfo Top, is 3,099 meters above sea level. Since ancient times Emei Mountain has been described as "Beauty Under Heaven". Temples were built as early as the Eastern Han



Dynasty (25—220) and Buddhism was introduced to the mountain during Jin Dynasty. In Ming and Qing dynasties there were more than 150 temples.

The main scenic spots on the mountain include the Baoguo Temple, Wannian Temple, Fohu temple, Qingyin Pavilion, Heilongjiang Tunnel, Hongchun Platform, Xianfeng Temple

(Jiulao Cave), Xixiang Pond and Golden Summit. These places are at different altitudes and have different climates. Temperatures at the top of mountain are 15 degrees lower than at the foot. Emei Mountain is a well-known natural museum with more than 3,000 specimens of plants and 2,000 types of animals including groups of monkeys that appear on the mountain roads and fascinate the tourists.



Jiuzhaigou Valley (九寨沟)

1. Brief Introduction

Located in Nanping County, Aba Tibetan-Qiang Autonomous Prefecture,



Jiuzhaigou Valley is 450 kilometers from Chengdu the capital city of Sichuan Province. It is China's premier national park ranging between 1,990m (6,529 feet) to 4,764m (15,630 feet) above sea level and takes up an area of more than 60,000 hectares.

The area consists of six scenic spots—Changhai, Jianyan, Nuorilang, Shuzheng, Zharu and Heihai. It becomes a world renowned scenic spot because of its diversity in natural scenery including snowy peaks, double waterfalls, colorful forests and green sea. Furthermore, Tibetan customs are another attraction. It was



declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1992; the park joined the Man and Biosphere Conservation Network in 1997. Jiuzhaigou Valley provides spectacular scenery throughout the year making it one of China's premier tourist destinations.

4. Attention

- ✧ Carry medicine or portable oxygen bottle to prevent from highland sickness because the altitude of Jiuzhaigou is 1,990m (6,529 feet) to 4,764m (15,630 feet) above sea level;
- ✧ Carry ointment to prevent the skin burn from sunshine;
- ✧ Take more clothes with you. The temperature is so different from day and night. The average temperature in Jiuzhaigou is from 9° to 18° ;
- ✧ Everyone is responsible for fire control. No fires or smoking are allowed within the park;
- ✧ Everyone is responsible for protecting all natural life in the park.

Jiuzhai Valley has a complete range of accommodation options from 4 and 5 star international Hotels to no star hotels and traditional home-stays.
