Stockholm School of Economics' (SSE) China Economic Research Center is looking to hire two Research Fellows/Assistant Professors: one for one year and one for three years. We are looking to hire people to start approximately November 1, 2009 (the start date is somewhat flexible). Successful candidates should have a Ph.D. and a strong interest in management research focusing on China. Good written English skills and knowledge of statistics are also expected. Candidates will work with Professor Carl Fey's research group which investigates what types of management practices are most effective in China. The group combines people based at both the China Economic Research Center and the Institute of International Business (both at SSE). Cross-country comparative work is also often undertaken.
