MINUTES

1. IACMR Current Status Report (Jia Lin)

IACMR co-President Professor Jia Lin Xie started the meeting and gave a brief history of IACMR, the Statement of excellence, and then introduced the 2010-2012 officers. She also reported on the status of current membership (as of June, 2010):

- Paid members: 2124
 - Student: 820 (39%)
 - Academic/Professional: 1247 (59%)
 - Researchers in Research Institutes: 57 (2%)
 - PRC: 1379 (65%) Non-PRC: 745 (35%)
- Countries and regions: 96

2. Review of activities in the past year

1) IACMR co-President Professor Jing Zhou summarized the officer retreat that took place in Hangzhou after the IACMR Shanghai meeting this past June. She mentioned that there were lively debates but leadership came to agreement on some important decisions for the future of the association.

2) IACMR co-President Professor Jia Lin Xie reported on behalf of the representative-at-large (Asia/Pacific)/newsletter editor TK Peng on the current status of the newsletter. Professor Xie also introduced the new editorial team.

3) One of the Research Committee members Professor George Chen reported on the activities by the research committee with an emphasis on the Li Ning Dissertation award.

4) Professor Larry Farh, one of the senior editors of MOR, reported on the status of the association journal Management and Organization Review (MOR) on behalf of Chief Editor Professor Anne Tsui. He talked about the effort that went into creating the journal, recent special issues, and encouraged everyone to support the journal by submitting manuscripts.

5) IACMR secretary/treasurer Eva Yao gave a summary of the financial health of the association and emphasized the need for continuing growth of membership in support of the association in the long term.

3. 2010 conference in Shanghai

IACMR 2010 program chair/Senior VP Professor Chao Chen summarized the Shanghai conference for the audience.

4. Announcement of the 2011 IACMR Research Methods Workshops

IACMR co-President Professor Jia Lin Xie announced that IACMR will have two research methods workshop in 2011, one in Taiwan (July 19-22) and another in Xiamen (July 24-27).

5. Report of 2012 conference

IACMR 2012 conference program chair Professor Larry Farh and co-chair Professor Howard Davies talked about the plan for the next conference and the location (Hong Kong).
